- 3. Describe the opportunities, challenges, or issues of interest to you as you imagine the focus of your final summative project. What new knowledge and skills would you hope to develop in working on this project? (800-1,000 words)
- 4. Identify a book you have read in the past year that has had a significant impact on your Christian life and faith and your practice of ministry. What new theological issues emerged from your engagement with this text? What critiques would you have of this book? (1,000-1,200 words)
