General Summary: The Director of Christian Education will provide vibrant and well-structured leadership for the children's ministry programs at CN Jenkins Memorial Presbyterian church, through developing caring relationships with children and their families; facilitating their growth in faith and involvement in the life of the church; planning and implementing educational programs; and recruiting, supporting and training servant-leaders.

Essential Functions:

- Develop, oversee, coordinate, and actively participate in programming involving children, youth, and their families for Sunday Christian Education (i.e. Children's Church and Sunday School) Summer V.B.S., and fellowship activities
- Develops meaningful and caring relationships with children, youth, and their families through engaging in a ministry of presence
- Works with the Christian Education (CE) program to create and implement a vision for Christian education for children and youth
- Works closely with the CE program leaders to develop all aspects of the Children's ministry of the church.
- Assists the CE program in providing leadership development training for children's servant leaders
- Works closely with the current children's ministry leaders (Sunday School Superintendent and Children's Church) to enhance CE opportunities for children and families
- Works with Associate Pastor to selection or develop curriculum that benefits children and families
- Develops and implement innovative ways to make CE more effective through continuing education/leader retreats etc.
- · Assists in identifying, recruiting and equipping servant leaders for Children's Ministry
- Is an advocate within the church for CE
- Ensures child and youth protection policy is upheld
- · Periodically reviews goals and philosophy of CE program
- Assists church secretary in compiling and maintaining database for all children and youth

- Coordinates with Facilitates Manager and other appropriate committees in the use,
 upkeep and furnishings of the children facilities
- Attends weekly staff meetings and weekly Sunday morning children's ministry programming
