- Experience working with young adults (e.g.: college residential life, AmeriCorps, Peace Corps, university student activities, student organization leadership/advising, faith community, religious education/formation)

## **QUALITIES**

This position requires a person with experience and enthusiasm for working with young adults in the university setting, willing to take initiative and work independently on program planning, and who can work collaboratively to contribute to achieving mission outcomes.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Coordinate and lead bible studies and Christian education/formation opportunities including mission trips and retreats
- Coordinate and lead weekly worship; including preaching, and selecting music and liturgy
- Plan and lead fellowship events for students
- Provide regular opportunities for students to connect one-on-one for spiritual care, as well as emotional support
- Create and nurture student leaders that meet regularly to plan and oversee fellowship, study, and worship opportunities
- Collaborate and cultivate relationships with other relevant campus organizations, departments and officials, contributing community colleges, and churches in the Presbytery of Wyoming
- Determine future funding model and act to secure financial resources
- Create promotional resources and branding materials
- Create and maintain website and other forms of social media
- Document mission outcomes through photography, videography, participant narratives/stories, written observations, surveys, interviews, and other outcome measures
