



Ferncliff Summer Staff Job Descriptions

Summer Chaplain/Worship Coordinator

Responsibilities:

- Oversee the worship elements of camp programming for overnight and day camp, including Morning Celebration and Vespers
- Create meaningful, creative, relatable, and unique worship experiences for campers that connect with summer and daily themes
- Coordinate with the weekly volunteer chaplain to plan and lead worship, and provide them with requested resources
- Lead music and/or recruit staff to sing or play musical instruments for song leadership in worship
- Set up all technical equipment for worship, including speakers, amps, projectors, and computers
- Provide pastoral care, nurture, and support to the Summer Staff, including counselors and coordinators
- Model Christian practices of hospitality toward the summer staff
- Communicate regularly with the on-site Coordinators about issues, concerns, program suggestions, and the overall wellbeing of counselors and campers each week
- Communicate regularly with the Camp and Events Coordinator about program suggestions, staff performance and health, and the overall wellbeing of the program each week

Relationships and Accountability:

- Accountable to the Associate Director, to whom the Chaplain relays any questions or concerns

Essential Functions:

- The ability to lift 35 pounds
- The ability to comfortably lead worship and music
- The ability to provide spiritual care to staff and campers
