The coastal town of McClellanville is located halfway between two of the oldest South Carolina cities, Charleston to the south and Georgetown to the north, and thus is a short commute from these cities. McClellanville is also centered for adventurers and sportsmen in between Cape Romain National Wildlife Refuge (CRNWR) and Francis Marion National Forest (FMNF), so public beaches, fishing, golf, and nature trails both in FMNF and nearby rice and garden plantations are easily reached by car. CRNWF is accessible by boat.

Our vision is to grow our faith and church community through meaningful teaching at Worship Service and enjoyable fellowship opportunities for all ages. These opportunities will lead to more growth and fellowship which in turn will nurture our understanding of Christ's teachings.

The vision is lived out through Biblical worship service, Sunday School, and fellowship including congregational dinners, Lenten suppers, community Bible studies, Men's and Women's groups, various missions, and fun family events such as an ice cream social, cookouts, an annual oyster roast, Montreat Conference Center / Youth Conference, and other youth activities. We are also planning to revive an old New Wappetaw custom – an annual beach picnic which would involve a boat ride to the Cape Romain National Wildlife Refuge.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

Our community is growing. In addition to long established residents, we have new families and as well as retirees flocking to our quaint little village. We want to offer something to everyone; that is, to foster, nurture, and strengthen Christian faith not only with fun activities, but with traditional Christian teachings, purpose of prayer, and with love of each other and Christ.
